<ul> <li>Request to revisit County Noise Ordinance; Planning will check with Environmental Health to learn more about enforcement and report back to the group, but any changes will not impact or be included in the zoning ordinance</li> <li>Design Standards – existing standards were augmented; all changes came directly from the NFO Community Plan         <ul> <li>C. Architecture – suggested calling for architecture that strongly enhances overall downtown district; continuity of scale and storefront rhythm; look for continuity of bulk and rhythm of frontages</li> <li>F. Materials – suggested replacing "Minimize" with "Coordinate/harmonize/balance" use of colors</li> <li>H. Signs – suggested adding point to encourage local artist collaboration (specifically murals); suggestion to limit the area of sticker signs in windows (see E.) and suggested looking at City of Redwood City's language</li> <li>I. Landscaping – suggested adding trees, encouraging ornamental, appropriately scaled trees</li> <li>Planning will remove the graphic examples from the Design Review section, relying instead on the existing reference to Chapter 7 of the Community Plan</li> </ul> </li> <li>Question about whether use permits were or were not required for ground floor residential. Discussion confirmed that they are required specifically for ground floor residential, in order to allow an extra level of review, but use permit renewal would not be required, as it would for a typical business use.</li> <li>Question about encouraging outdoor seating/dining</li> <li>Already allow 10 ft setback; it is possible to allow additional setback with permit for outdoor seating</li> <li>Afready allow 10 ft setback; it is possible to allow additional setback with permit for outdoor seating</li> <li>Opesine for seating in the right of way should be brought up with Dept. of Public Works</li> </ul>
